

Availability in 2011

As you know, beginning on the first Tuesday in March 2011, *Aurora*, the magazine of the Diocese of Maitland-Newcastle, will appear in a new format, as a supplement to *The Newcastle Herald*, distributed to a potential 50,000 readers.



Aurora will be readily available in a number of ways:

- take out a year's subscription for \$25 by contacting the Editor;
- purchase *The Herald* from the newsagent on the first Tuesday of each month;
- have *The Herald* delivered by your newsagent;
- read in full online.

Each edition of *The Herald* has a print surplus. These copies will be given to the Chancery and will be distributed first to subscribers and to Bishop Michael's mailing list, then free to the parishes via the parish mailout. The parish priest can distribute these latter copies as he chooses - on a 'first come, first served' basis at Masses, to the housebound and local aged care facilities etc.

Clearly the number received by parishes will be significantly fewer than has been the case. If larger numbers are required, parishes can arrange orders with local newsagents at parish expense. These copies can then be sold or given to parishioners.
