**In 2010 BBI will be accredited through  
The University of Newcastle and will be launching a:**

- Certificate in Youth Ministry (0.5 year)
- Diploma in Theology (1 year)
- Bachelor of Theology (3 years)
- Graduate Certificate in Theology -  
Youth & Campus Ministry (0.5 year)
- Master of Theology - Pastoral Ministry (1 year)

These offerings give both emerging and experienced youth and campus ministers, excellent opportunities to develop their skills in this specialised ministry.
