*In July 2011, Morisset Cooranbong Wyee Parish, will celebrate the 150th Anniversary of the very first burial on 'cleared ground' that was to become **Cooranbong Catholic Cemetery**.*

*And again in **November 2011**, we will celebrate the 150th Anniversary of the completion and opening of a one room humble timber building, purpose built as a **Catholic Church**, and as a **Non Vested National School**, marking the beginnings of a Catholic presence in the Cooranbong Community.*

*We are also very proud of our connection with the Sisters of St Joseph, from 1800 to 1867, with a documented visit on **April 20 1895 from Mary MacKillop**, now our own St Mary of the Cross, and a continuing connection with the Sisters of St Joseph at St John Vianney School, Morisset from 1961.*
