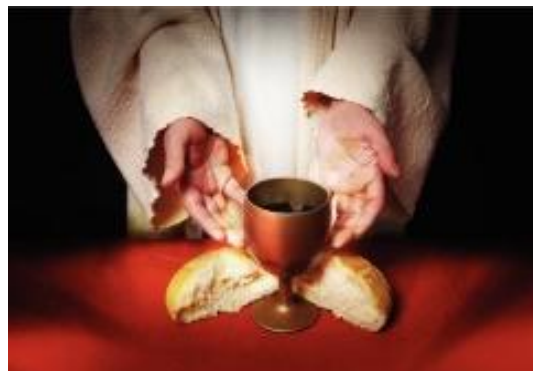


## A FRESH LOOK AT THE MASS

During 2011 a new translation of the Roman Missal will be introduced into all parishes across Australia and the English speaking world. The Newcastle Deanery has decided to prepare for this by offering a series of workshops on the Mass during Lent. Sr Carmel Pilcher, who has specialised in the study of Eucharist, has been invited to lead this course focussing on the Mass and our participation. This is a good opportunity to come along and reflect on the Eucharist with fresh eyes.

(week beginning 14 March)

**Session 2** The People of God are nourished by the Word  
(week beginning 21<sup>st</sup> March)

**Session 3** The People of God offer Christ's Sacrifice  
(week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> March)

**Session 4** The People of God go forth to live the Mass  
(week beginning 4<sup>th</sup> April)

The session for each week will be repeated at a number of venues. Participants can attend any of the venues over the course of the four weeks, depending on their own schedule.
