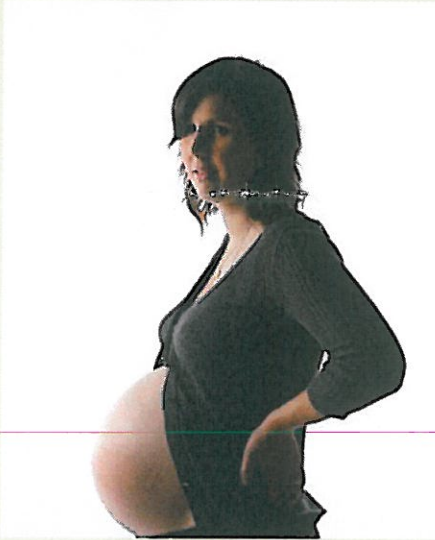


## Pregnancy Care Network



The aim of this initiative is to encourage every community to take action to meet the needs of women experiencing unintended pregnancy by sponsoring 2 people to undertake our short course. This training is provided to suitable people who will be equipped to meet the initial support and decision making needs of women during this challenging time.

Many women who have experienced abortion, have said that if only one person had said... *'I will help you!'*... or offered a supportive gesture, the time to talk through their fears, anxieties, hopes and dreams, that they would have felt more able to continue their pregnancies.

**The aim of the Pregnancy Care Network** is to provide an Australian wide network of professionally trained and supported pregnancy support consultants so that every woman has access to timely, qualified, compassionate assistance from someone without a financially vested interest in the outcome of her decision.

Suitable candidates for this course will already have a qualification and experience in a relevant discipline such as nursing, allied health, social work, psychology, or education, (although not necessarily still practising in that profession).

Graduates of the short course may be eligible for accreditation as an  
**RCA Pregnancy Support Consultant**  
and successfully completed units can be credited toward completion of our  
**Certificate IV in Pastoral Care.**

**The training is undertaken by distance education and can be completed in less than three months.**
