APPROXIMATELY 1500 VESSELS ARRIVE IN NEWCASTLE EACH YEAR AND SOME 32,000 SEAFARERS (ENOUGH TO FILL ENERGY AUSTRALIA STADIUM) VISIT THE PORT OF NEWCASTLE. THESE SEAFARERS PLAY AN ESSENTIAL ROLE IN THE PORT OF NEWCASTLE BEING ONE OF THE BIGGEST IN AUSTRALIA.

THE CENTRE PROVIDES A SAFE PLACE FOR VISITING SEAFARERS TO RELAX, CALL HOME, ACCESS THE INTERNET AND PURCHASE BASIC SUPPLIES.

TYPICALLY THE SEAFARERS ARE AT SEA FOR MORE THAN 4 MONTHS WITHOUT CONTACT WITH FAMILY & FRIENDS
