



Fireman Fabrice goes into Harold Bear and Dolly

Fabrice wears a mask and special coat to stay safe.




Policeman Patrick and Social Worker Sarah take Baby Beatrix and Harold Bear to a safe place. They are good toys.




Policeman Patrick and Paramedic Peter take Father Frank to a safe place, where they can help him not be angry.




Paramedic Peter is at the accident. His job is to repair the broken teddies.




Policeman Patrick is at the accident. His job is to keep all the dollies safe.




Dolly Denise is going to her new house with social worker Sarah. She will now live with carers Craig and Clara. They will make dinner, wash her clothing and take her to school.




Dolly Denise is going to a new school. She likes to play netball. There are other dollies at the school who like to play netball as well.



Dolly Denise is taking her toys and clothes to her new house. She will decorate her new room when she gets there.




Harold bear has moved to a new place. There are lots of fun things to do there.




Howard bear's parents cannot take care of him any more. Sometimes, grownups find it difficult to take care of bears. Harold didn't do anything wrong.




Harold's parents cannot take care of him any more.

Harold is a good bear. They still love him.




Harold bear doesn't live with his parents any more. He now lives with carers Craig and Clara. Harold still gets to have ice cream, when he's been good.



Harold bear is living with Grandma Gertie and Grandpa Geoff. He is sad. He cant live with mum and dad any more. They still love him.




Harold bear feels very angry. Mum and Dad left him, because they thought it would be better that way. They still love him very much.

Howard will feel better, later.




Harold bear now lives with carers (raig and Clara.

Harold. Other things are the same. Harold still rides


his bike, watches television and reads books.




Harold bear lives with carer Craig and Clara now. They do some things differently, which makes Harold angry. All changes are difficult, but you get used to them after a while.




Mother Margaret died in a bad accident. Harold bear worries about dad getting hurt in an accident. This is not very likely. Accidents don't happen very often.




Dolly Denise is playing at the park with her new friends. She feels better now.

Harold bear is talking to social worker Sarah about things he used to do with mum and dad.


Some of these memories are happy, others are sad.




Harold feels sad. sometimes, talking to people can help. There are lots of people you can talk to: teachers, friends, carers, nurses...




Harold bear lives with carers Craig and Clara. He still visits his parents on weekends.
