WYD Specific- What to pack

Leaders Tip: A3 paper & pens for daily notices, post-retreat materials

Chaplains: Mass kit, liturgical vestments as needed

For the main events: am/fm radio for translations, a roll of toilet paper for porta-loos.

For the sleep out: sleeping bag, ground cover (i.e. tarp), sleeping mat, travel pillow, a bag to carry your overnight gear.

General Pilgrim tips: If you're carrying your passport in a travel pouch/money belt, place it in a ziplock bag to protect from water damage.

Aussie souvenirs to swap.

Adaptors & Power boards (label your chargers).

Small bible, (or App) rosary beads, any other prayer materials required.

 - Sydney group check-in
 - Luggage Allowances
 - International Airlines from and to Australia
 - 30kgs
 - Airlines within Europe 23kgs
 - Number the pilgrims bags from 1 to 40 and add a ribbon.
 - Its then easier to find which ones are missing

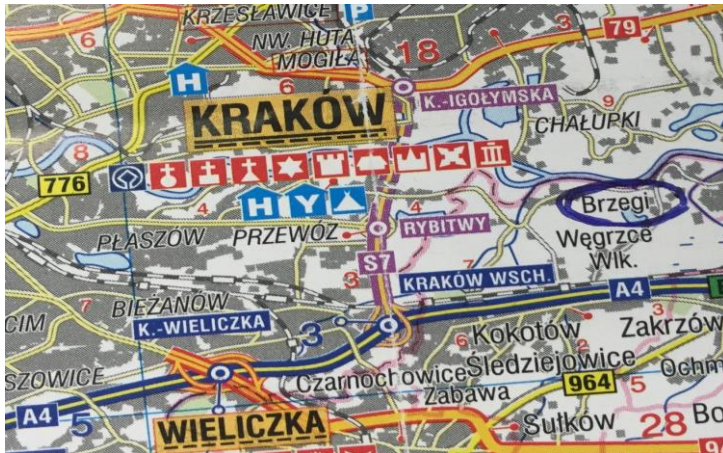

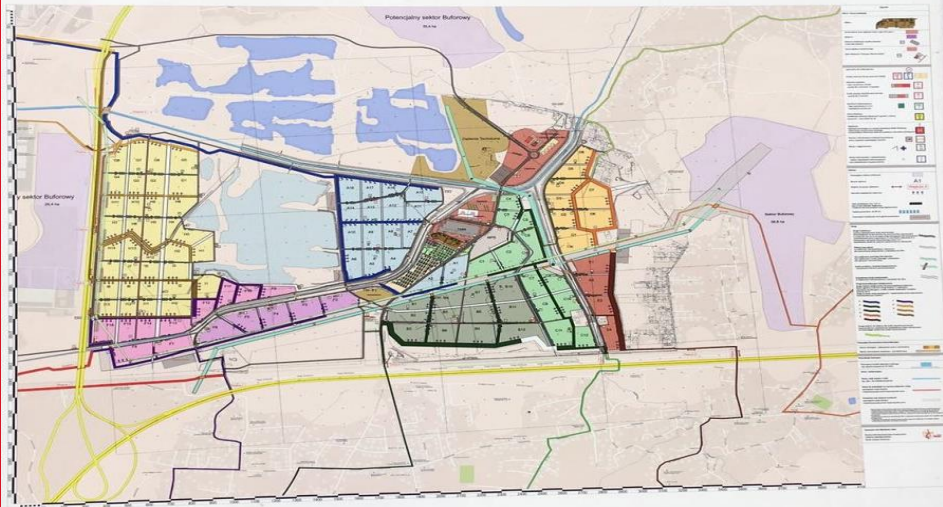

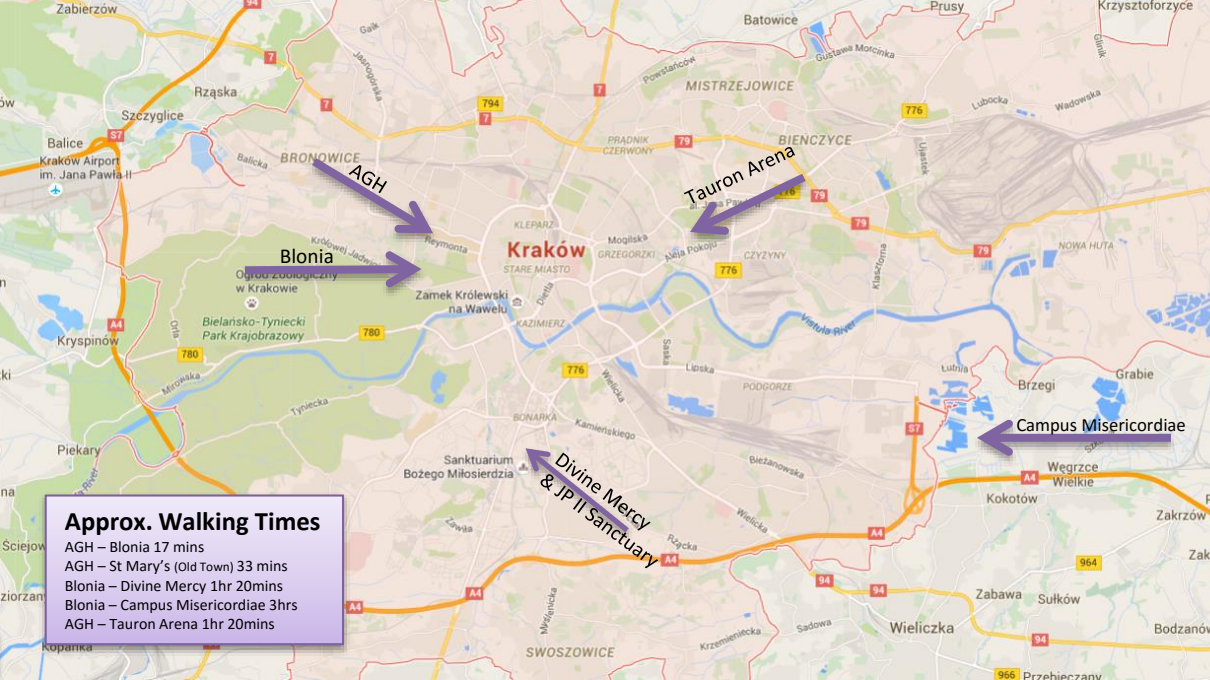
Updates from Krakow WYD Organising Committee

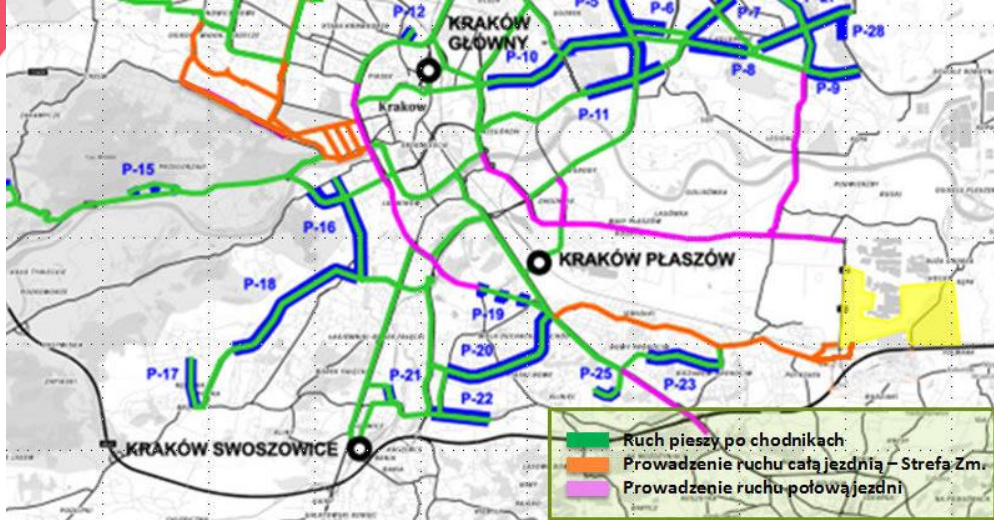

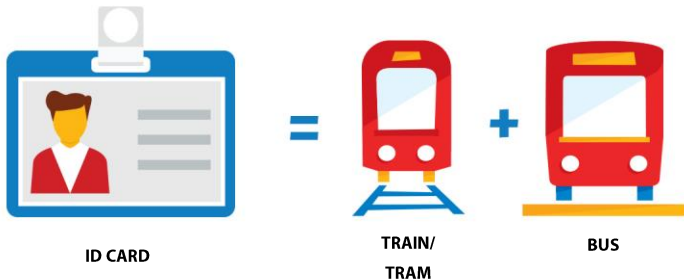
The mobile application and the website will provide a list of places offering specialized meals.
