Meeting Report



May 2023

At their May 11 meeting the Diocesan Liturgy Council members:

- studied Chapter I a. 33-46 of the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy.
- reviewed pastoral guidance document on the Rite of Baptism for Children, for dissemination to the community.
- were updated on progress of conversation to establish appropriate consultation process between the diocesan property team and liturgy council when sacred buildings are being planned or renovated.
- were updated on progress of Communion from the Chalice resumption recommendations.
- received a report from council reps of their initial meeting with Bishop Michael to introduce the work of the Council.
- were updated on upcoming activity of St Josephine Bakhita Working Party.
- attended their annual council dinner.

The work of the Council extends beyond its meetings, particularly through its subgroups and currently includes:

- working with the College of Assistant Masters of Ceremonies on liturgies with the Bishop presiding
- the work of the Christian Initiation Forum:
 - Preparing resources and engaging in initial conversations with those parishes wanting to reimagine the ministry of Christian Initiation
- Facilitating formation including:
 - o 'Grace, Simplicity Order' a formation and discernment process for those who have expressed interest in the ministry of Assistant Master of Ceremonies
 - o *Stepping Stones* formation for St Benedict's Inner Newcastle Parish who are in the process of establishing a parish bereavement team.
 - o With Clergy from overseas who are new to the diocese
 - o Supporting deacons in the liturgical aspect of their ministry
 - o Considering the ongoing development of liturgical protocols and practices for the Cathedral
- Supporting parishes preparing for the sacraments of confirmation for children

The Diocesan Liturgy Council serves the diocesan community in promoting the principles and practice of the sacred liturgy. <u>Information about this Council is available online</u>. The ongoing work of the Council is supported by the Pastoral Ministries Worship and Prayer team.
